# **Gain Knowledge On Medieval Boots**

You'll find medieval boots in many different sizes, shapes, and colors. People of different areas and backgrounds recognized that different types of boots were needed for different tasks. Folks also loved variety in their choice of footwear as much as they do now. I wrote this page to talk about the various types of medieval footwear. The first thing we should go over is the many different types of unique medieval footwear. The Altair boot, cavalier boot, castle top leather boot, King Henry boot, high boot with fringe, Locksly boot, low boot without fringe, low boot with fringe, musketeer boot, leather calf boot, phantom boot, captain boot, viking boot, dragoon boot, swashbuckler boot, high seas boot, D'Artagnan boot, and the villager boot were all popular in the middle ages.

The first type of boots we will discuss are cavalier boots. These boots extended all the way up to the knees and had large fold over cuffs at the top. The cuffs could be folded inside or outside depending on the wearer's preference.

Now we'll talk about Altair [medieval boots](#). The Altair boot also extended up to the bottom of the knee and provided protection to the wearer's shins. It was made from two parts and could be modified to remove the shin protection.

Castle top leather boots are the next type of boots we will discuss. These boots got their name by having crenellation edges on the top of them. Extending all the way up to the knee these boots provide great shin protection. The Showtime series *The Tudors* showcases these boots on the character Henry.

High boots with fringes are very common medieval boots. They are made of suede and resemble moccasins in their design. The boot extends up to the knees and folds down to the outside. Its laces go all the way from the bottom to the top of the boot.

King Henry boots are very tall boots and can go all the way up to 25 inches. Materials used in replica King Henry boots are leather and suede.
